1. Enter the 2026 Parade of Homes

a. All Parade of Homes contracts and associated documentation must be submitted to the Home Builders Association of Northwest Michigan, Inc. (HBANWMI) office, located at 3040 Sunset Lane, Traverse City, Michigan no later than 4:30 p.m. Friday, May 1, 2026. By initialing each page and completing each document provided, you agree and adhere to the rules.

2. Parade Participation Contract and Fees

- a. Participant must be an active member in good standing of the HBANWMI (Member application can be found on the HBANWMI home page).
- b. A signed contract and entry fee payment in full is required to enter into an agreement with the HBANWMI for home entry, advertising, and promotional services related to the 2026 Parade of Homes. Fee is non-refundable.
 - i. 2026 Parade of Homes entry fee BEFORE February 28, 2026: \$2,700
 - ii. 2026 Parade of Homes entry fee AFTER February 28, 2026: \$3,500
 - iii. All registrations include the following marketing package valued at \$3,500*:
 - 1. Matterport 3D Immersive Tour up to includes up to 4000 square feet. (An additional charge may be assessed for homes larger than 4,000 square feet)
 - 2. Full-page listing in Parade of Homes Tour Guide highlighting your entry.
 - 3. Full-page ad adjacent to his/her display page in the 2026 Parade of Homes Tour Guide.
 - 4. Listing included on the HBA Website and the 2026 Parade of Homes Website
 - 5. 10-minute Guest Segment on the Special Edition Parade of Homes episode of the HBANWMI 'Building Better Podcast'
- c. A Surety (Performance) Bond of \$750.00 will be collected at the time of application. If no violations occur by the builder, full reimbursement will be issued after the 2026 Parade of Homes event has been completed and all HBANWMI-owned materials have been returned (signs, etc.). The Parade Builder has the right to appeal any violation charges, in writing to the Board of Directors, whose decision shall be final.
- d. Failure to abide by the Rules and Regulations of the 2026 Parade of Homes contract will be considered a violation of this contract. Violations will result in the forfeiture of part or the entire \$750.00 bond. Non-compliance with any section of the contract by the Builder may result in the automatic removal of the Parade Home from the 2026 Parade of Homes event and the forfeiture of the \$750.00 bond. Other violations of the Rules and Regulations set forth in this contract will be assessed as follows:

1 st Violation	\$200	Total Penalty	\$200
2 nd Violation	\$250	Total Penalty	\$450
3 rd Violation	\$300	Total Penalty	\$750

e. The Parade of Homes Committee has sole discretion over the content of advertising and promotional services provided in conjunction with the Parade of Homes. The Parade of Homes Committee reserves the right to edit any tour guide submissions that do not meet the HBANWMI standards of quality, integrity,

- and ethical business practices.
- f. Parade contracts and required documentation must be received by May 1, 2026, deadline or a \$500 late submission fee may be assessed. The HBANWMI reserves the right to reject any contract submitted after the contract deadline, even those accompanied by late submission payments.

3. Parade of Homes Dates and Hours of Operation

Sunday, June 21	11:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.

4. Builder Eligibility Requirements

- a. Builder must hold an individual Michigan Residential Builder license which is current and valid.
- b. In the case of an LLC, Sole Proprietorship, or Corporation, the Resident Agent/Qualifying Officer of that entity must hold an individual Michigan Residential Builder license which is current and valid.
- c. Builder or Resident Agent of a Builder's LLC, Sole Proprietorship, or Corporation must be the signatory on the contract.
- d. Builder must be a member in good standing of the HBANWMI.
- e. Builder entering this contract states that he/she is the owner of the home plans and/or has exclusive rights, including copyright, to construct the home.
- f. Builder agrees to defend, indemnify and hold harmless, the HBANWMI, including its officers, directors, employees, and agents from any and all claims of third parties, including, but not limited to, copyright infringement or conversion, which may be asserted as a result of the inclusion of the home in the 2026 Parade of Homes, or the inclusion of drawings or floor plans of the home in any printed or electronic publication of the HBANWMI, publicizing or in conjunction with the 2026 Parade of Homes.

5. Subcontractors, Suppliers, and Builder Agents

- a. The HBANWMI encourages Builders to exclusively utilize HBANWMI member subcontractors and suppliers for Parade homes.
- b. Sub-contractors and Suppliers must be current HBANWMI members to market themselves and/or their products during the Parade at the Parade home. Allowing non-members to participate or advertise is considered a violation of this contract.

6. Final Inspection and Certificate Deadlines

- a. All Builders must submit the following documents by 4:00 p.m., June 12, 2026.
 - i. Temporary or Final Certificate of Occupancy.
 - ii. Certificate of Insurance for the Parade Home providing Commercial General Liability Insurance and naming the Home Builders Association of the Grand Traverse Area, Inc. as additionally insured. The coverage limits shall be not less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence and \$2,000,000 aggregate.
- b. A final inspection performed by a representative of the Parade of Homes Committee may take place one week prior to the Parade.

7. Parade Rules and Regulations

- a. The HBANWMI is allowing new homes, with a Certificate of Occupancy received no sooner than January 1, 2025, to be eligible as a 2026 parade home.
 - i. Pre-sold Parade Homes require a signed Homeowner Release Agreement prior to the opening of the Parade.
 - ii. Homeowners in these occupied homes must also agree to vacate the premises during the judging and the entire Parade, June 18 through June 21, and agree to allow their home to be open to the public throughout the Parade of Homes.

- b. New homes that were previously featured in a Parade of Homes may be re-entered into the 2026 Parade of Homes.
 - i. The 2026 Parade of Homes Tour Guide will note those homes that were previously entered.
 - ii. Previous year awards may be displayed in the home.
- c. Parade homes must be open to the public throughout the entire Parade of Homes designated days and hours.
- d. Home Exterior: The Builder will provide finished sidewalks and driveways, and shall have all siding, painting, and/or brick on the exterior of the Parade Home(s) completed. The front yard will be landscaped with a "finished" look, seeding or sod is required, with the rear and side yards in the final-grade stage so the home is accessible and safe. Any exceptions to this rule must be reviewed with the Parade Committee.
- e. Home Interior: The Builder agrees that the entire interior finish shall be in place and interior painting shall be completed. Floor coverings shall be installed, and all fixtures shall be in place. There must be no unsightly storage.
- f. Any portion of the home that is intended to be finished by Parade that has already been started prior to Parade, must be completed to be judged and opened to the public.
- g. Furniture: The Builder has the option of showing the Parade Home furnished, partially furnished, or unfurnished.
- h. Home Features: The Builder agrees to provide a listing of features and details of their Parade Home(s) for the general public.
- i. During the hours of operation, the HBANWMI requires the Builder or on-site builder representative to have a phone so that the HBANWMI or Parade Committee members can contact that home.
- j. The Builder shall not require the public to remove their shoes before entering a Parade Home, except for pointy-heeled shoes. The Builder may use runners on the floor and/or provide shoe covers to protect the floor coverings. Shoe covers are the responsibility of the Builder and may be purchased at many medical supply companies.
- k. The Builder will provide a table and two chairs to adequately accommodate the non-profit personnel working at the home, selling tickets, and providing information to the public about the home and Builder. Though a port-a-potty is not a requirement, it is encouraged for volunteer and visitor usage.
- I. The Builder will provide additional seating for the public and a functional shoe-covering container (if applicable) at the home entrance.
- m. The Builder may use areas of the home as a sales area to promote their business or that of the HBANWMI member sub-contractors and suppliers who participated in the construction of the Parade home. Sub-contractors and Suppliers <u>must be HBANWMI members to market themselves and/or their products during</u> the Parade.
- n. No individual price tags will hang from products within the Parade home. Product and price lists are acceptable. It is up to the Builder to "police" their Parade home for compliance.
- o. The HBANWMI will provide a numbered promotional flag sign to be placed in the ground in front of the home. It is the builder's responsibility to pick up the sign from the HBANWMI office and return the sign within 1 week following the Parade.
- p. The Builder understands that no yard signs will be posted at the Parade property during the Parade except the Parade sign provided, the builder sign, and the real estate sign (if applicable). The real estate sign cannot obstruct the event signage or violate local regulations.
- q. The Builder agrees to prohibit the sale of food or drinks on the premises, nor promote any other organization than the HBANWMI and local non-profit partner organization.
- r. Alcohol is strictly prohibited on-site at the premises of the Parade home(s) during operating hours of the Parade.
- s. The Builder is to notify all neighbors in the immediate area of the home being shown (any neighbor that may be affected by Parade traffic) no less than 2 weeks before the Parade.

8. Builder Provisions

a. The Builder will receive a full-page display page in the 2026 Parade of Homes Tour Guide along with the

adjacent page for advertising, digitally the Tour guide is archived on the HBANWMI website in perpetuity. See Addendum A for-display page requirements and information on submission of Parade home information.

- b. The home will be listed on the NW MI Parade of Homes App and Website; the Builder can provide up to 15 photos per listing listings remain active through April 2027.
- c. Builder contact information shall include address, phone, and website. The HBANWMI member company primary member is the name that will be published and recognized in all official Parade of Home marketing.
- d. The Builder's project will be displayed on the NW Michigan Parade of Homes and HBANWMI websites.
- e. The Builder will receive one large number specific Parade flag sign. Additional signage may be provided by request and at the discretion of HBANWMI.
- f. The Builder will receive twenty (20) complimentary 2026 Parade of Homes tickets for the builder's use in promoting the event. Additional tickets can be purchased by the builder at 50% off.
 - i. Stacking ballots is prohibited.
 - ii. Builders should encourage ticket holders to vote for their favorite home in each category.
- g. The Builder will be provided with volunteer personnel to host the home during the event.
- h. The Builder will receive a discounted rate of 30% on any additional advertising purchased in the Parade of Homes App (enhanced options) or Tour Guide.

9. Required Tour Guide Submission Materials for a Parade Home

- a. See Addendum A for information on submission of Parade home information.
 - i. Home price category is listed "AS IS" without land.

10. Substitutions

a. Parade home entries may be substituted by the builder provided that a payment of \$500 is included with the new entry details. The builder may also be billed an additional amount to cover the actual costs incurred for having to recreate advertising materials. No substitutions allowed after April 17, 2026.

11. Withdrawal of Entry

- a. If a builder has signed the HBANWMI Parade of Homes contract, paid the applicable fees, and has decided to withdraw, the Builder must submit a written request to the HBA Parade of Homes Committee providing the reason for withdrawing from the 2026 Parade of Homes.
- b. There will be no refund of entry or advertising fees paid.
- c. The Builder may be responsible for additional costs incurred by the HBANWMI for advertising material modifications and to notify the public, volunteers, and other stakeholders about the withdrawal of the entry.

12. Parade Tour Guide Review and Approval of Copy

- a. The 2026 Parade of Homes Tour Guide Listing proofs will be provided digitally, it is the responsibility of the Builder, or Builder representative to verify and approve.
- b. Each participating Builder is required to review the 2026 Parade of Homes Tour Guide and sign off with approval. Those who do not review their submission accept the materials as prepared without expectation of revisions, after the printer's deadline.
- c. Neither the HBANWMI nor its employees, agents, or representatives will be liable for any damages related to misprints, errors, or omissions that may occur on the Builder pages or within the advertising appearing or failing to appear within the publication. The HBANWMI will not be held responsible for any misprints, errors, or omissions of the printer after the Builder or Advertiser proof review has been completed.

13. Awards and Judging

a. The Parade of Homes entries will be pre-judged by independent judges on Monday, June 15, 2026, and/or Tuesday, June 16, 2026. The builder or representative from the company must provide entry into the home at the pre-scheduled time. The HBANWMI will present award announcements for display prior to the

opening of the Parade.

- b. Independent judging categories include:
 - i. Best Primary Suite
 - ii. Best Kitchen
 - iii. Best Interior Design
 - iv. Best Exterior Design
 - v. Best Craftsmanship
 - vi. Best Overall Winner (Extraordinary detail, design, quality, and perceived value)
- c. The People's Choice will be awarded in each category per public vote during the Parade of Homes.
- d. Awards and a press release will be distributed after the Parade concludes.

14. Failure to Abide by Rules

- a. Failure to follow the agreements established in the Parade of Homes contract may result in a loss of participation privileges for up to two (2) years as recommended by the Parade of Homes Committee and approved by the Board of Directors. The Builder has the right to appeal in writing to the Board of Directors.
- b. Depending on the violation, an independent third-party group may be consulted at the sole discretion of the HBANWMI Board of Directors.
- c. Failure to abide by the Parade of Homes contract will be considered a violation of this Contract. Non-compliance relative to necessary signatures, waivers, agreements, Certificates of Occupancy, or Certificates of Insurance will result in automatic withdrawal from the Parade of Homes.

15. Misunderstandings or Disputes

- a. The requirements contained within this Contract are discretionary with the HBANWMI. The Board of Directors is responsible for determining Contract compliance. The Board of Directors shall be the authority in resolving disputes regarding this Contract.
- b. Any further contested decisions are to be resolved through mediation or with legal counsel in Grand Traverse County, Michigan. The Builder is responsible for any fees or costs incurred by the Association in enforcing this Contract and resolving disputes.

16. Security

a. Builders shall be solely responsible for the security of their Parade home, both during construction and during Parade of Homes.

17. Contract Conditions

a. This Contract shall be binding upon both the HBANWMI and the Builder for themselves or any entity they represent, their successors and assignees.
